Dominique Frenette

Vice-President, Investments

Dominique Frenette joined the Lucie and André Chagnon Foundation in January 2018 as Director, Investments. Since March 2020, he has held the position of Vice-President, Investments, heading up the team responsible for managing the Foundation's investment portfolio, including mission investments. Mr. Frenette came to the Foundation with over 20 years' experience in financial markets with institutional asset managers and financial institution treasury.

He began his career with Elantis Investment Management (subsequently Fiera Capital), where he was primarily responsible for managing fixed income and preferred shares portfolios, and monitoring the portfolio credit quality.

He then moved on to the treasury department at Laurentian Bank, where he held several positions in capital management during a period of over 12 years. In addition to working on optimizing use of the bank's capital, he created the Equity Proprietary Trading business line and was also closely involved in the selection process for external managers for the employee retirement funds.

Dominique Frenette studied accounting at Murray State University (Kentucky) before obtaining a bachelor's degree in business administration and a master's degree in finance at University of Sherbrooke. He also holds the *Chartered Financial Analyst (CFA)* designation.
